Live aquatic plants, live fish, used equipment and manufacturers' donations of their products, such as fish food and aquarium related equipment, will all be in the auction! There will also be a few Vendors in the room selling their hobby-related wares.

The auction is open to the public, both for selling items or fish/plants and for being a bidder in the auction! All are welcome and there is no charge to attend the auction! Always so much fun, the auction starts at noon and will continue until the last lot is sold. TFCB thanks you in advance for your generosity supporting our club!



### Auction Rules for Sunday June 9, 2019

1. There is no charge to attend the auction and the public is welcome!
2. The auction will begin at 12 noon. On-site registration of lots will open at 9:30am Sunday.
3. Each vendor must fill out an auction entry form. The vendor does NOT need to be a member of TFCB.
4. Limit of 4 lots per species per vendor.
5. Limit of 40 entries per vendor. Split is 60% of selling price to Vendor and 40% to TFCB if lots are preregistered and lot registration form is received by May 31, 2019; 50/50 split after that date. 6. Additional entries per vendor will be accepted as a donation to TFCB.
7. No minimum bids can be set unless authorized before auction begins.
8. All entries must be registered by 12:00pm on June 9, 2019.
9. Each entry should be marked as to what it contains (species, number of fish, if it is a pair, trio, etc.) and the assigned entry number.
10. Entries for breeder programs should have breeder credit forms submitted with Lot Registration.
11. Each bidder must fill out auction bidder form to get a bidder card.
12. Checks will be mailed to each Vendor within 2 weeks of the end of the auction. Vendor payouts *may* be available at the conclusion of the auction if the Treasurer deems it possible.
13. The auction is open to the public; anyone can enter lots for auction; non-members are welcome and encouraged to participate in the auction.
14. All used equipment should be clean and in good working order.
15. All fish must be double bagged. Fish not bagged properly will be re-bagged at a charge of \$2 per lot.
